The Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC) will soon be preparing its Annual Status Report of the Appalachian Development Highway System (ADHS) and its Local Access Road (LAR) Projects Report. The reports will cover the period from October 1, 2016 to September 30, 2017 (FY 2017). We request that you contact your State Departments of Transportation (DOT), as you have in previous years, and work with them to complete the ADHS and LAR update for your State by October 25, 2017.

The status report in the ADHS web based system at RTI should be completed by October 25, 2017. Please notify us when your State DOT has completed the ADHS update.

The LAR projects update will use the attached Excel spreadsheets for those States with LAR projects. We request that the following State DOTs: Alabama, Georgia, Maryland, Mississippi, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, South Carolina, and Virginia, review and update the status of their LAR projects as of September 30, 2017. Please ensure that the ARC project number is entered into the spreadsheet. The LAR updates are due to Mr. Everett Matias at <a href="mailto:everett.matias@dot.gov">everett.matias@dot.gov</a> and Mr. Jason Wang at <a href="mailto:jwang@arc.gov">jwang@arc.gov</a> by October 25, 2017.
